Space has been reserved for Specialty field entrants to train on, at the Bong State Recreation Area, in Kansasville, WI! Please read all the following information:

**The site is made available for you to use – you must make your own training group contacts & arrangements.

Different dog training areas are reserved exclusively for Flat Coat trainers' use each day. Other field trainers may be using the unreserved areas. (These unreserved areas will not be off-limits to Flat Coat trainers, but others **must be accommodated & respected.) Check with Karen Peterson for specifics.

** The Wisconsin DNR charges an entrance fee to the Bong grounds. \$10 / day for out-of-state residents, or \$35 annual pass

** There are no nearby food vendors. Bring food and water for yourself, & water for your dogs.

** There are no waste receptacles at Bong; trainers **must** take out all waste.

** You may wish to reserve ducks from a nearby supplier, at \$11/bird. These **must** be picked up yourself – 5 mi. from Bong—& **reserved, with deposit**, in advance. Wayne Wilkinson will coordinate the order; contact him at: wawilkinson@comcast.net, **before** May 1.

Directions to Bong Recreation Area:

From I-94, a few miles north of Kenosha, take exit 340. Go west on WI-142, approximately 8.5 mi. Just past WI-75, the Bong entrance is on the left.

(These grounds are in southern WI, approximately 2 hours south of the field event site in Manitowoc, and en route for most Specialty-goers coming from the east, south, & west.)
